- Page 35:** Change "Idaho State University" to read "the University of Idaho."
- Page 50:** Change "to design new species" to read "to design new genera"
- Page 101:** Both references to "human chromosome 16" should read "human chromosome 11." (Note: one is in the text, one in the caption to Figure 4.3)
- Page 103:** Change "*The Language of Life*" to read "*The Language of God*."
- Page 124:** Change "But in reality no organism has yet to be identified..." to read "But in reality no organism has been identified..."
- Page 125:** Change "That key, as has been..." to read "The key, as has been..."
- Page 149:** "It produced hunter-predator marsupials like the dingo and the Tasmanian tiger, ..." should read "It produced hunter-predator marsupials like the tiger quoll and the Tasmanian wolf..."
